Clarification

Why this form?

With this form persons can submit an application for a 'Not Applicable Statement' (NVT) (section 1a of the Admission and Expulsion Act WTU-BES). Fill in one form per applicant.

Who qualify for a Not applicable statement?

- a. Dutch nationals who were born on or in Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands or obtained Dutch nationality, if and in so far as the WTU-BES is not applicable to the parents;
- b. Dutch nationals who immediately prior to 10 October 2010 resided on the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba for an uninterrupted period of at least one year and who were born on or in Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands, or obtained Dutch nationality during their residence on Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands;
- c. Children of the Dutch nationals mentioned under b, who immediately prior to 10 October 2010 resided on the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba for an uninterrupted period of at least one year.

What happens to your application?

If you have submitted your application in person at one of the offices of the IND Caribbean Netherlands Unit (see below for the addresses) and your application is complete, your application will be processed. If your application is not complete, it cannot be assessed. You will receive a written notification when a decision has been made on your application.

Please note! For registration in the personal records database a birth certificate that is legalised or provided with an apostille is required.*

Children from the islands of the public bodies: Dutch nationals born on Bonaire, Sint Eustatia or Saba or who have obtained Dutch nationality and their Dutch children born in any place whatsoever.

- copy *legalised birth certificate of the child;
 - in the event of acknowledgement: copy *legalised deed of acknowledgement of the child;
- copy of the applicant's nationality certificate (it must be demonstrated that the applicant holds the Dutch nationality and has obtained this in the public bodies).

If the applicant was not born in the public bodies or obtained the Dutch nationality, please also add:

- copy *legalised birth certificate of the parents;
- copy of the parent's nationality certificate (it must be demonstrated that at the time of the applicant's birth the parent held the Dutch nationality and obtained this nationality in the public bodies).

Children from the islands of the public bodies: Dutch children who were born on or in Aruba, Curaçao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands or who have obtained the Dutch nationality and one of the parents can be regarded as a child from the island.

Dutch nationals who were born on or in Aruba, Curaçao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands or have obtained Dutch nationality and who immediately prior to 10 October 2010 resided in the public bodies for an uninterrupted period of at least one year.

- extract from the personal records database demonstrating the residence history in the public bodies;
- copy of the applicant's nationality certificate (it must be demonstrated that the applicant at the time of residence in the public bodies had Dutch nationality and obtained this nationality on Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands).

Children of the above-mentioned Dutch nationals if they resided on the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius of Saba immediately prior to 10 October 2010 for an uninterrupted period of at least one year.

- copy of a valid Dutch passport of the child;
- copy of a valid Dutch passport of the parents;
- copy *legalised birth certificate of the child;
- copy *legalised birth certificate of the parents
 - in the event of acknowledgement: copy *legalised deed of acknowledgement of child;
- copy of the parent's nationality certificate (it must be demonstrated that the parent at the time of residence in the public bodies held the Dutch nationality and obtained this nationality on Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten or the European part of the Netherlands).
- extract from the personal records database demonstrating the residence history of the child and the parent in the public bodies;
