1.1 ID number

Please state here the number shown on your ID card (Sédula). The number consists of 10 digits, namely the year (YYYY), month (MM) and day (DD) of your birth, followed by the two final digits.

1.2 First name and surname

Please state your first name, your other initials and your surname as shown in your passport or on your ID card (Sédula).

1.5 Nationality and place of residence

If you do not have Dutch nationality, you must fulfil the following 3 conditions:

- You must have lived in the Caribbean Netherlands for at least 10 years.
- During the 3 months prior to your studies you must have lived in the Caribbean Netherlands.
- You are entitled to Dutch student financing. The conditions can be found at duo.nl.

If you are not Dutch and do not fulfil these 3 conditions, state your nationality under 'Other', on which island you live and how long you have lived there.

2.1 Information by email

You can choose to receive the information about your start-up allowance by email. The benefit of doing so is that you are not dependent on postal deliveries. However, you should make sure that we always have your most recent email address and that all messages do not end up in your spam box.

3.5 Structure of study programme

Do you not know which learning pathway or level you are enrolled in? If so, check with the college administration department.

3.7 Enrolment date

The academic year in vocational education runs from 1 August up to and including 31 July and in higher education from 1 September up to and including 31 August. If your enrolment starts later in the academic year, for example on 1 February, please select 'other' and indicate the date of your

enrolment. If you have any doubts about the correct enrolment date, please contact the college administration department.

4 Start-up allowance

You can have your start-up allowance paid out a maximum of three months before your study programme starts.

NB: We must have received evidence which shows that you are going to attend a study programme in the Netherlands before we can allocate you the start-up allowance.

4.1 Borrowing

You can also borrow money in addition to your performancerelated student loan.

NB: You will pay interest on the borrowed amount. You must repay the loan including the interest, even if you graduate.

⁵ Support with your move to the Netherlands

The supervising organisation will arrange, among other things, your flight to the European Netherlands, support when you arrive in the Netherlands and help with taking out insurance policies. We will make sure the supervising organisation contacts you. If you wish to make use of this offer of support, you must sign an authorisation showing that you give your permission for us to pay out part of your startup allowance directly to the supervising organisation. The rest of the start-up allowance will be paid out to you.
