



Travelling in the Dutch Caribbean



Passport control

If you are travelling between Saba and St. Eustatius, there will be no passport control. However, if you are travelling from these islands to St. Maarten or St. Kitts and vice versa, passport control will take place, as you are travelling to or from the Dutch Caribbean.

Border police tasks in the Dutch Caribbean are the responsibility of the Royal Netherlands Marechaussee. On the islands of Saba and St. Eustatius, your passport will be checked if you are travelling to or from the Dutch Caribbean. In addition, your identity may always be checked by verification of the name on your boarding pass.

The Royal Netherlands Marechaussee may still ask you for your passport or identity as part of a random check. They do so to fight cross-border crime. In that case, only your identity will be determined. Please note: you always need your passport or identity card when travelling.
