What is the Safety Network?

It is often thought that the Saba Care and Safety House is a building where people can find shelter. That is not the case. It is a partnership between seven healthcare organisations, the Public Entity of Saba and the Justice Department, in which the various parties work together to draw up a joint plan of approach to tackle complex problems together. The aim is to provide you with the support needed to help you move on with your life.

Your situation has been reported to the case meeting. What does this mean?

An organisation that you know has reported your situation, because it believes you need support from multiple organisations. The goal is, that the relevant organisations liaise with each other and work with you to determine what can be done to reduce the problems and worries you are experiencing.



What happens after a problematic situation has been reported?

After registration, we will assess the complexity of the problems to determine whether a joint approach is needed. If so, the problem that you or your family are facing will be brought to the case meeting. In this meeting, the various organisations that can help you discuss your situation.

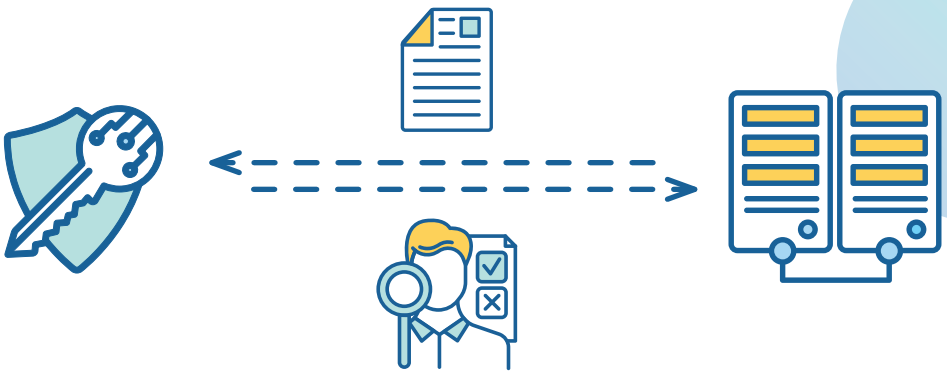
How do you know what has been discussed?

During the meeting, a case director is appointed. He or she is your first point of contact and will tell you what has been discussed and how the organisations can assist in handling the problem. Together with the case director, you determine what you can do and what kind of support you would like to receive.



What happens to this information?

The Safety Network records information and the agreements made in a registration system. In addition to personal data, such as your name, address and date of birth, we will record what problems have been observed, which organisations are involved, and what the plan of approach is. All data collected is subject to the Personal Data Protection Act BES (PDPA BES). This means your personal data will only be used for the purposes for which they have been obtained. The data will be recorded and stored in accordance with the privacy protocol of the Safety Network Saba. For more information, please contact the process manager.
