

If you unexpectedly have substantial essential expenses that you cannot pay then the SZW Unit of RCN may be able to help you with special social relief. Unexpected substantial expenses that the SZW can contribute towards include pulling teeth, a refrigerator, washing machine or bed. The SZW can also support you with the purchase of school supplies for children in secondary education.

Special social relief is not paid in cash. If you qualify for it then the SZW pays (part of) the unexpected expenses directly to the supplier.

What expenses?

If you have been registered for at least 5 years, are over the age of 18, and your income is below 120 per cent of the statutory minimum wage then you may be eligible for an allowance for the following expenses:

- Funeral expenses
- Costs for the filling of a water tank and replacement of a water pump
- Water consumption costs (temporarily in case of payment arrears)
- Costs of school uniforms and school supplies for secondary education. Is your child in primary education? Then you can apply to the Public Entity.
- Costs of baby necessities and baby bed
- Costs of a mattress and/or a sofa bed
- Costs of a ventilator (for a family with an elderly person or child), refrigerator, stove, washing machine
- · Costs of double rent
- Costs for personal contribution towards a social facility
- Dental expenses
