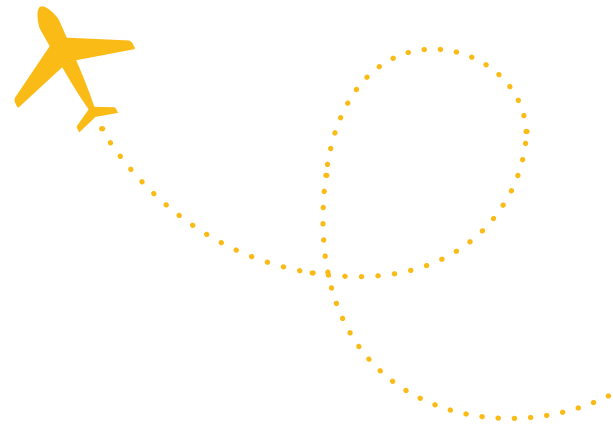

Checklist

Are you travelling with a minor child? Or is your child travelling alone or with someone else? Before departure, check which documents are required. This helps prevent unpleasant situations during departure. Use this checklist to see what documents you need for each situation and where to obtain them.



Is the child travelling with *both* parents?

Bring with you:

- Valid passport of the child
- Valid passports of both parents



Is the child travelling with *one* parent?

The required documents depend on the custody situation.

Both parents have custody

Bring:

- Valid passport of the child
- KMar travel consent form, downloadable via www.rijksdienstcn.com/ConsentformtravelingKMAR
- Copy of the ID card or passport of the other parent

One parent has custody

Bring:

- Valid passport of the child
- Valid passport of the parent
- Extract showing sole custody, available from the court registry
- Any applicable court ruling or decision

Important: If you have sole custody of the child, permission from the other parent is not required. However, you must be able to prove that you have sole custody.



Is the child travelling *alone*?

A minor child may travel alone. If the child is under 18 years old, it is advisable that the child can demonstrate that the parent(s) or legal guardian with custody have given permission for the trip.

Bring with you:

- Valid passport of the child
- KMar travel consent form
- Copy of the ID card or passport of the parent(s) or legal guardian with custody
- Proof of custody or guardianship, available from the court registry or civil registry extract



Is the child travelling with *someone else*?

For example, with a grandparent, family member, friend, school, sports club or supervisor.

Bring:

- Valid passport of the child
- KMar travel consent form
- Copy of the ID card or passport of the parent(s) or legal guardian with custody
- Proof of custody or guardianship, available from the court registry
- Details of the accompanying person



Is the child *under guardianship*?

Bring:

- Guardianship order, available from the court registry
- Copy of the ID card or passport of the guardian



Has one parent *passed away*?

Bring:

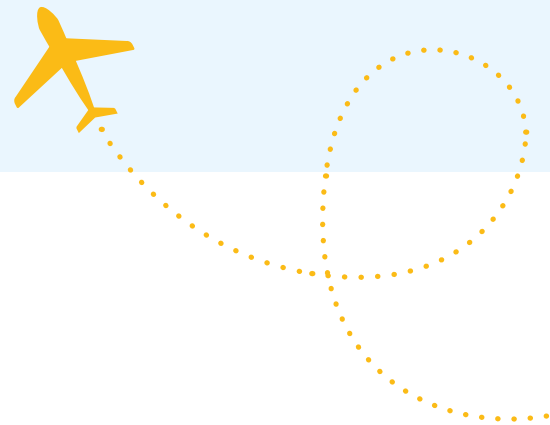
- Valid passport of the child
- Proof showing who has custody or guardianship



Before departure

Check that all documents are available.

- Documents checked
- Documents printed
- Digital copies saved
- Documents packed in hand luggage
